## SANDING SEALER & WAX - P3960

Additional Supplies Needed: sandpaper (80, 120, 220 and 400-grit), 2 lint-free cloths

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Sand Car Body Sand car with #80-grit sandpaper, followed by #120-grit. Wipe car to remove dust.
- **2. Apply Sanding Sealer** Using the Foam Brush, apply Sanding Sealer in a thin, even coat. Let dry thoroughly. (Approx. 20-30 minutes. Drying times may vary).
- **3.** Sand Car Body and Re-apply Sealer When dry, sand car with #220-grit sandpaper. Wipe car to remove dust. Apply at least 2-4 coats of Sanding Sealer (repeat Steps 2 and 3). Sand lightly on final coat. **NOTE**: Car must be thoroughly dry before painting. If car is damp, paint may bubble.
- **4. Paint Car** Once you are satisfied with car surface, paint as usual. Sand lightly with #400-grit sandpaper between coats. Apply a final light coat of paint, but do not sand. Let dry thoroughly.
- **5. Apply Wax** Apply a small amount of Wax to cloth. Wipe Wax over car surface and let set a few minutes. Wipe off car with a clean, dry cloth.
